

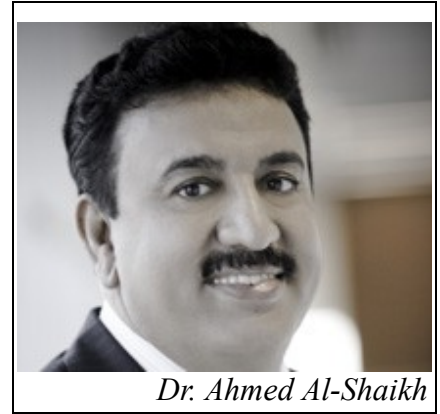

Dr. Ahmed Al Shaikh is the Vice President of the Enterprise and Human Capital Development Division at Tamkeen (Labour Fund). He is responsible for executing the human resources development and private sector support initiatives which constitute a major element of the labour market reform project and Tamkeen's mandate.
